School Uniform.

St. Patrick's School has a distinctive uniform of which we are proud. Acceptance of a place at the school implies support for the Uniform Policy and parents are asked to give their full support in maintaining high standards by adhering strictly to the policy. If a parent is in any doubt about any item of uniform the Headteacher will gladly assist before a purchase is made.

General Uniform Reminders -

- Hairstyles are expected to be neat, tidy and sensible
- Long hair must be tied back at all times with ribbons etc. in the school colours
- Boys must not have logos shaven into their hair – shaved patterns or mohicans are not acceptable
- Make up, nail varnish and tattoos may not be worn
- One set of stud earrings may be worn (rings, necklaces, bracelets are not permitted)
- Only school caps can be worn - not baseball caps.
- Non uniform woollen hats without logos may be worn.
- Badges and pins other than the school badge are not permitted
- All items of uniform must be labelled with a child's name
- Boots are only to be worn in extreme weather conditions when a change of footwear must be brought into school

If for any reason your child is unable to wear the full uniform, please make an appointment to speak to Mr Cranitch.
