



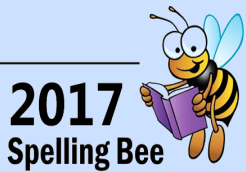
# ST PATRICK'S NEWS

Tickets are available to purchase for the disco - see over for details.



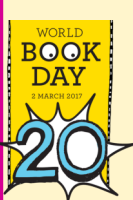
Thank you to all of the children who took part in the Spelling Bee and to Miss Towsey for organising the event. More details in next weeks newsletter.
