The London Grid for Learning is a community of schools and local authorities committed to using technology to enhance teaching & learning.

From Friday 28th April children will no longer be using Fronter but will be using MyUSO on the LGfL to access the resources directly.

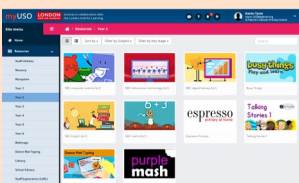


The link to MyUSO will be in the same place as the Fronter link on the school website.

Usernames will not change but children in EYFS and KS1 will use the Easy Login PIN Code (the day and month of their birthday) instead of a password.

KS2 will use the same usernames and passwords as at present. All children will be receiving new login cards.

When logging in the children will see the same resources as those they currently have access to.

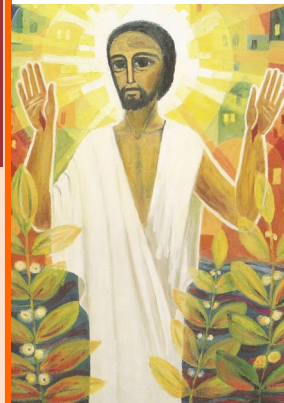
