

## *From Easter to Pentecost*

During their RE lessons the children will continue learning about the resurrection, the appearances of the risen Christ, the Ascension and the period from Easter Sunday to Pentecost.

Belief in the resurrection is presented as one of the founding beliefs of Christians and, together with the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost as the reason for 'caritas'; love of God that leads to acts of charity. The children will be focussing on the Gospel of Luke and Acts of the Apostles, also written by Luke. By the end of the half term, it is hoped that the children will have a strengthened sense of belief in the resurrection of Jesus and a willingness to accept the obligation to care for those less fortunate than themselves.

Remember, you are the first educators of your child in faith. Your child's learning in religious education will be much greater if you and the school are engaged in talking and praying about their learning.



## **Slapped Cheek Syndrome**

**There have been some cases of Slapped Cheek Syndrome within the school.**

Although the rash can look alarming, slapped cheek syndrome is normally a mild infection that clears up by itself in one to three weeks. If you're pregnant, have a blood disorder or a weakened immune system and have been exposed to the virus, you should seek medical advice.
