As a celebration of science week, we want you to design an exhibit for a science fair in school which children from other classes will be able to come and visit.

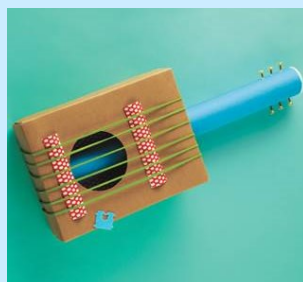
