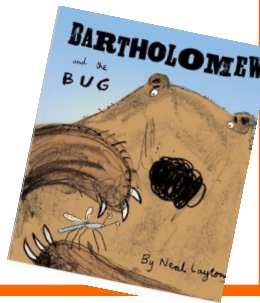
Friday 9th May 2014

Dear Parents,

Summer Term Building Fund – Gift Aid

I would like to thank all those parents who made a contribution to the Spring Term's building fund. As you know, as a Voluntary Aided School we have to pay 10% of all major building repairs and maintenance from the school fund paid by parents. These repairs and maintenance costs can be substantial.

We plan to make further improvements to your child's learning environment and with your continued support we should be able to achieve this.

As most of you are aware, we ask that each parent makes a contribution of £10 per child or £20 per family per term. Please place your contribution in the envelope provided and return this to the office as soon as possible.

I am also writing to ask if you would Gift Aid your donation. By signing a Gift Aid Declaration Form, the school can claim from the tax office, an additional 25p for every £1 you donate to the school fund, provided you are a UK taxpayer.

All you need to do is complete the form on the back of this letter. There will be no difference to the amount of tax you pay and you do not need to inform the tax office. This is a very easy way for the school to get some extra money.
