MAYOR OF LONDON TEAM LONDON

Our assembly this morning was presented by Tanya, a member of the Team London Young Ambassadors volunteer programme. The Mayor of London's volunteer programme for schools aims to inspire young people to engage in social action, both in their school and the local community.

Tanya explained how volunteering helped her to turn her life around, with the impact she had on the children she met inspiring her to enrol in university and get a degree.

Year 5 then spent some time with Tanya, thinking about living in London: homelessness, litter, how we judge others and how we can help those less fortunate than ourselves. The children were really inspired by Tanya's story and are already thinking about ways they too can make a difference.
