We managed to avoid the rain and the sun made a brief appearance for our lovely May procession on Thursday afternoon.

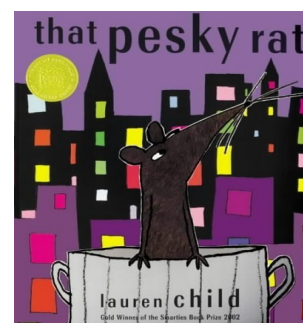
Each of the children had a flower and we processed around the playground, singing hymns to Mary and carrying our flowers.
