Why not visit the pharmacy instead of waiting for a doctor appointment?

Pharmacy teams can help you look after your own and your family's health without having to go to the GP all the time. Some pharmacies also run a minor ailment scheme for common health problems like aches and pains, skin conditions and stomach upsets. If your pharmacy runs a minor ailment scheme, the pharmacist will be able to assess your needs, give you advice, suggest medicines if appropriate, and refer you to a GP if necessary.

When pharmacies provide medicines as part of a minor ailment scheme, you get the medicines on the NHS. If you normally pay a prescription charge, this charge will apply here. If you're exempt from prescription charges – if you're under 16 or over 60, for example, or if you have a prescription pre-payment certificate (PPC) – you won't pay for the medicine.
