## Staffing next year.....

As you are aware, a number of meal supervisors left last week and their duties have been taken on by our existing support staff. We have restructured the way we support the children because, like all primary schools in Camden, we have experienced cuts to the size of the funds that are available to us. There will be further changes to staffing because of these pressures, but we are doing our very best to ensure that all the children will be properly supported next year.

Every class will have at least one class teacher and some classes will continue to have the support of more than one teacher for some of the time. Each pair of classes will have two teaching assistants allocated to them. So every class will have a teaching assistant in it for most of the time, just as now. There will be a teacher, a SENDCo who will not have a class who will have responsibility for organising and managing the provision for children with additional special needs. Children with statements and health care plans will continue to receive one to one help.

If you have any concerns about what is happening, please do not hesitate to make an appointment to see me.

My door is open and I will readily listen.

Details about the deployment of staff next year will be available next week.
