School Uniform

We are having a renewed emphasis on school uniform. All children are expected to be in school in full school uniform.

- Only school caps may be worn to school - with peaks to the front.
- Grey school trousers must be worn, grey tracksuit bottoms are not permitted.
- Plain black school shoes must be worn. No canvas shoes or trainers.
- Only grey or white socks or tights can be worn.
- Ties must be worn by boys & girls, unless girls are wearing summer dresses.
