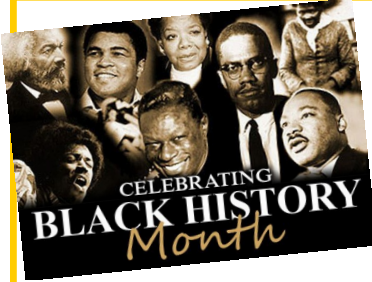




ST PATRICK'S NEWS
