# Genesis 2 teaches me

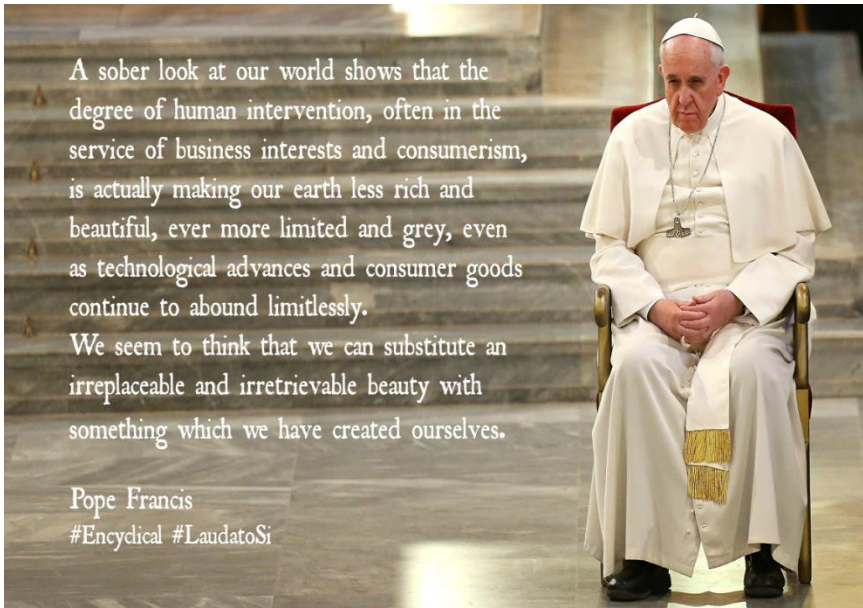


- ❖ Genesis 2:15 teaches me to love and take care of the Earth because it says “to cultivate it and guard it.”
