If you are interested and would like your child to attend please let the office know.

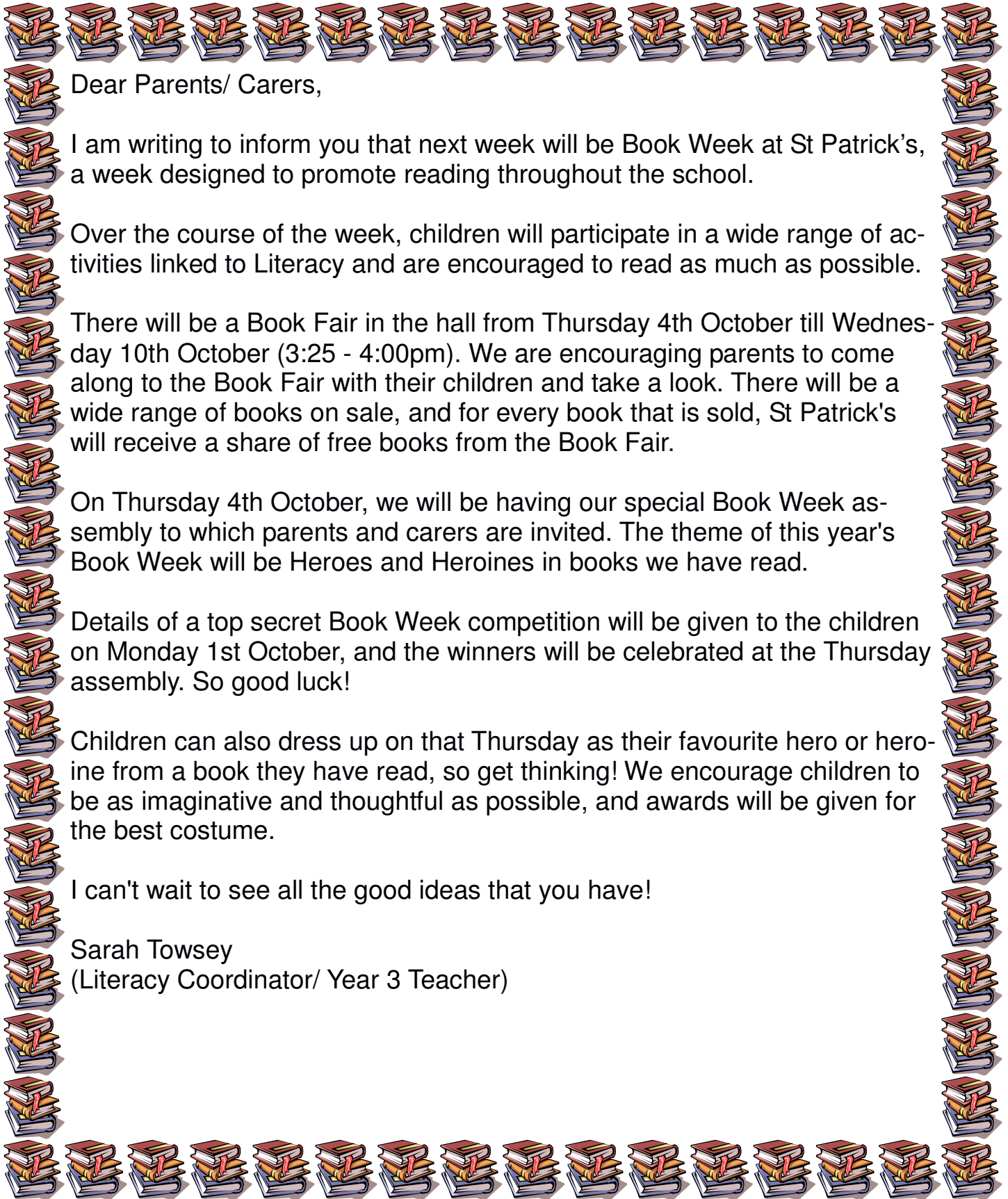
