





Genesis 2




- Genesis 2 is a creation story in the Old Testament (the beginning of the bible)

What does Genesis 2 teach us?


- Genesis 2 teaches us to value the Earth as much as God does.

Laudato Si



- Laudato Si is a letter meaning Praised Be. It was published in May 2015.
- The letter was written by the pope (Pope Francis) saying that the Earth needs to be looked after otherwise there will be no Earth again and that the Earth is a mother and we are hurting it by littering and polluting. The Pope (Pope Francis) got his inspiration from St Francis who loved the environment and nature.

What does Laudato Si teach us?



- Laudato Si teaches us that if you do not look after the world there will be no world again ever.
- In Laudato Si it says “If we approach nature and the environment without this openness to awe and wonder, if we no longer speak the language of fraternity and beauty in our relationship with the world, our attitude will be that of masters, consumers , ruthless exploiters, unable to set their limits on their immediate needs.
- It also teaches us that when we do not look after the Earth properly, it cries out because we are hurting it.
- We can ride our bike to school or walk instead of taking the buses.
- We can pick up litter and throw it in the bin.
